Public Input Stacey Patton presented her interest in adding a yoga class for students to help with coping skills. She suggests a 3 year K-12 program, 1-2 times per week and daily for middle school opportunity hour. Cost to hire would be approximately \$70,000 plus benefits. Next step – Stacey should talk to teaching staff and get their input. Following that the budget would need to be reviewed to see how or if we could fund the position

Facilities Projects- Mrs. Potter reported that the asbestos abatement on rooms 8, 9, & 10 will take place during spring break. The bids that were received came in for construction of the new classroom well above budget. The Board has chosen not to take action on accepting a bid at this time. Next step for the CTE classroom is to look at existing facilities instead of building from scratch. DSA will need to approve the space. Mrs. Potter will schedule a CTE Advisory Committee meeting to discuss new plans to be submitted to the State.

Annual Update of LCAP Goals-

- Surveys for LCAP-Parent Survey results from were shared. Overall there is an
 increase in the connectedness that parents feel with the schools. Details of the
 surveys will be posted on the LCAP. Teacher surveys results from LES were all
 shared in terms of Common Core implementation. Results show growth in all areas.
- Mrs. Potter will meet with CSEA to get feedback for the LCAP on April30. Sites will be reviewing and discussing LCAP goals and getting input to Mrs. Potter prior to the next meeting. The next meeting will be a two hour meeting in order to fully review the LCAP
- Evonne inquired about having a Community Day School- CD's are No longer separately funded. The funding is part of LCFF.
- **For intervention,** Garnet has been working with High School students at the Elementary school to increase reading skills. Possibility of working with Mary Norris at the Tribal Center for offering afterschool tutoring.
