She explained that the two areas she would focus on will be acknowledgement in the classroom and more direct intervention with families that have chronic absenteeism including finding the problem and working on individual solutions. Mary explained that the Tribe is also working on that directly with their membership.
- **Survey Development** (Include LCAP Priorities)-Survey development will commence shortly.
- Laytonville Elem. Const. Project & Culinary Arts Building There are a few minor details left to finish on the LEMS building. Negotiations are in progress for the penalty clause payment by the contractor. Next phase-demolition of other classrooms-Construction plans for new classrooms to go to DSA in October and hopefully be out to bid by February 2019. CTE Culinary building at the High School-Due to rising materials costs, the original stick construction plan is too expensive. Modular building plans are in the works. Don shared the modular plan with DAC and asked for input. Suggestion made for outdoor sink and portable compost receptacle to facilitate garden/kitchen integration.
