-Approval of Minutes of April 18, 2018: Motion to approve the minutes by Nancy, Second by Konnie. All in favor.

-**Facilities Update:** Finish work getting done, internet, electrician, Joanie hopes to have the new rooms available for tours by open house. CTE Facilities grant on the way towards acceptance. Progress on demolition of old buildings.

-**LCAP:** Joanie shared a compilation of data showing our progress toward our LCAP goals. Discussion about teacher response to the Standards Implementation survey. Discussion about parent involvement. Parent survey is too complicated, can we make it really simple? Pupil Achievement, decline at LES, increase at LHS. LHS testing being taken much more seriously because the results are being used by 4 year and community colleges for placement. Student engagement/course access, increase in CTE pathway completion, decrease in chronic absenteeism and increase in attendance rates. School Climate-suspension rates are not really dropping, no expulsions, results not back from Healthy start survey. Other-PE, not super structured p-5, more skills based 6-8. PE p-5 needs to be refreshed. Local food options are increasing with community help.

Additional ideas/changes-continue looking for counselor, Aikido teacher in 7th grade, will continue next year and expand to 6-8. This year-full time intervention teacher, should we continue this? This year an IA in Continuation was necessary, next year there will be some changes in the way Continuation works (more online courses) that may allow that position to end. Decision to be made later. Garden position? Discussion about chemicals and cleaning procedures. Bussing-students getting to school too early-next year, back to 2 busses. Lunch, playground supervision-request for 1 more person. Joanie asks that any requests that need to be part of the budget be made asap.

- **Safety:** More discussion about busses at LES. Improvements will be made on the parking lot across from the office. Traffic monitor in the morning and afternoon? Request to refresh the yellow paint around the door openings. Janice needs yellow jacket traps.
