

Laytonville Middle School
General Rules for Athletic Participation

In order to be eligible to participate in athletic activities at Laytonville Middle School, the student must:

1. Be an enrolled student at Laytonville Elementary/Middle School (grades 6-8) or enrolled in Laytonville Middle School Independent Study Option Program (grades 6-8).
2. Have passed and submitted verification of a physical examination conducted by a medical practitioner. The physical must be dated after July 1 prior to the school year in which athletes will be participating.
3. Have proof of adequate health insurance.
4. Have attended a full day of school on the day of competition or if the game is on Saturday must have attended full day of school on the previous Friday. **Exception: Unavoidable Dr. appointment, funeral, or excused absence. The principal must approve absence.**
5. Must not have been expelled from a school because of disciplinary reasons.
6. Must have 2.0 GPA from the previous trimester. (Board Policy 6145 (a))
